How to apply

Create an account on the Institute website, verify your email address and complete the online application. The application can be saved and continued later. Applicants upload certified academic documents plus certified identity documents for the applicant and parent or guardian. Each upload is limited to 10MB.

Entry requirements

Grade A diploma programmes: LGCSE or equivalent with at least four passes, including one or two of English, Mathematics and Science. Grade B certificate programmes: LGCSE or equivalent with at least two passes, including one or two of English, Mathematics and Science. Grade C short and vocational courses: basic literacy; no formal academic qualification is required. Specific programme requirements can vary.

Grade A: Diploma programmes

Typical study period: Up to 36 months

Grade B: Certificate programmes

Typical study period: 18 to 24 months

Electrical Installation; Plumbing; Boilermaking; Millwright; Road Construction; Building & Civil Construction; Occupational Health & Safety; Trading (FX); Culinary & Hospitality Management; Film & Theatre; Carpentry & Joinery

Grade C: Short and vocational courses

Typical study period: Short courses / 12 weeks or institution schedule
